

How to add Kyocera printer on Mac

First thing to do is **contact IT Helpdesk**. We have to know your **login username** of your Mac in order to add your account into kyocera server.

After that, install a [kyocera drive for MAC](#). Install the 8052ci driver. Then go to system preferences → Printers → Add printer


Address - myq.cerge-ei.cz
