


# Wi-Fi 'residents' - Android Howto Guide

There are many Android flavors all around so be aware that configuration picture may vary...

- **EAP method = PEAP**
- **Phase 2 authentication = MSCHAPSV2**
- CA certificate = (Unspecified)
- **Identity = Use your registration email** (use lower-case letters only)
- Anonymous identity = leave blank !
- **Password = Use the password shown to you during registration** (see [details](#))
- No advanced options...
